

Disclosures for Political Survival Committee and the JCAR Community Involvement Fund

These disclosures reference the PSC Voluntary dues and CIF voluntary contributions listed on member dues invoices.

Payments to the Jefferson County Association of REALTORS are not deductible as charitable contributions; however, such payments may be deductible as ordinary business expenses in accordance with IRS rules and regulations. The \$32.37 of your year 2011 dues and \$25.00 for **PSF voluntary dues*** is not deductible as a business expense because this portion is used for lobbying or the support of candidates at the state and national levels. 70% of your **PSF contribution*** may be used by the PSC to support state and local candidates and issues and other grassroots activities. Until CAR reaches its RPAC goal 30% is sent to National RPAC to support federal candidates and is charged against your limits under 2 U.S.C. 441a; after CAR reaches its RPAC goal it may elect to retain your entire contribution for use in supporting state and local candidates. You may contribute more or less than the suggested PSF amount. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal and the National Association of REALTORS® or any of its state associations or local boards will not favor or disfavor any member because of the amount contributed.

****Contributions to the JCAR Community Involvement Fund** are not deductible for federal income tax purposes. The Community Involvement Fund supports community involvement and outreach to achieve a strong real estate market through public policies that support private property rights, home ownership, and quality communities. The first \$20.00 of all eligible contributions will be used by the 5280 Small Donor Committee to directly support candidates for local office who share these values.
